

## DISPOSAL OF WASTE ELECTRICAL & ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT (WEEE)

This symbol on electrical and electronic equipment indicates that at the end of its life, it should not be treated as household waste.

Each EU member state is required to reduce the amount of electric and electronic equipment sent to landfill each year. The UK currently throws away around 2 million tonnes of WEEE, which we should recycle if possible. If WEEE is not disposed of or recycled correctly, there could be potential harm to your health and the environment.



To ensure safe treatment and increase re-use and recycling of material we offer free **in-store take-back** for any waste electrical product **if you purchase a similar new product**.

Alternatively if you are not purchasing a replacement then the waste electrical product should be taken to your nearest designated collection facility for WEEE.
